

## No Bull Just Beer and Bikes Limited

1. On arrival collect wristbands from Office they must be worn at all times there will be no re-admittance to site without a wristband.
2. We do not allow teenagers under the age of 18 years to stay at Penmaenau without parental supervision.
3. Proof of age will be required when purchasing alcohol on site.
4. In the event of an emergency please contact stewards at office during office hours or at main bar outside office hours. In case of an emergency when office and bar are closed there is a number on the main gate
5. No child under the age of 14 allowed in the licensed area unaccompanied at any time.
6. During event there is No vehicular access or egress except in an emergency between 10pm and 9am.
7. The correct pass must be displayed at all times on the windscreen of your vehicle not relevant to bikes.
8. All cars, vans, campers, caravans, trailers and trailer tents are subject to a £10.00 charge payable in cash on arrival
9. Large vehicles (5m or over) in length are at the discretion of the management. Please email [info@nobullbeerandbikes.co.uk](mailto:info@nobullbeerandbikes.co.uk)
10. Blue badge holders' car/van entry is free, subject to validity checks. The charge of £10.00 for caravans still applies.
11. There are a limited number of disabled pitches available!
12. Please ensure that you have a working fire extinguisher in your caravan or tent.
13. Management reserves the right to ask anyone to leave at any time!
14. Refunds can only be granted at the discretion of the management!
15. Drunk and disorderly behaviour may result in you being asked to leave.
16. No generators between the hours of 10pm and 8am.
17. Any Noise nuisance that is disruptive to fellow campers will not be tolerated.
18. You will only be allowed to bring alcohol onto this site if you are over 18 years of age and it is purely for your own consumption. Excessive amounts noted in vehicles or in your possession may be confiscated and returned to you on your departure.
19. If you do bring alcohol to this site it is to remain in the confines of your tent pitch it is not to be carried around or to be consumed in the Licensed Area's.
20. No campfires to be made on the ground you may use barbeque trays, no live flames etc., use of BBQ are subject to weather if it has been consistently dry prior to event we may get advice from Fire authority to not allow, due to the fire hazard.
21. Photographers will be present onsite during the event. The photographs taken will be used purely for publicity purposes. If you do not wish to appear in any publicity photographs please contact us.
22. We do not allow dogs at our events except for guide dogs.
